


How to plan your visit:

- Contact the site BY PHONE
 - Provide your contact information, email, class size, number of chaperons, and pick the field trip option you would like.
- Decide if you will be paying by cash or check. If you are paying by cash, all the money needs to be collected prior to arrival at the site. (Checks should be made out to NCDNCR) (\$1.07 per student/\$2.14 per parent).
- Decide if you would like the gift shop order form for students. These can be distributed to students and when groups arrive we will collect orders. While the group is on tour, we will fill all orders and give teachers the items when they leave.

About Us


Historic Bath seeks to preserve the history of North Carolina's oldest town. The site offers insights into 18th and 19th century life in a port town.

FIELD TRIP OPTIONS:

Each field trip option includes watching our 15-minute orientation film.

Option 1: Tour of the Palmer Marsh House, Hands-on quill writing activity, Rope making demonstration.
(1.5 hours)

Option 2: Tour of the Palmer Marsh House, Hands-on toy making activity, Colonial toys & games demonstration.
(1.5 hours)

Option 3: Tour of the Bonner House, Butter churning demonstration, Hands-on candle making activity.
(1.5 hours)

Option 4: Tour of the Bonner House, Open Hearth Cooking or a weapons demonstration, Townball
(1.5hours)
